

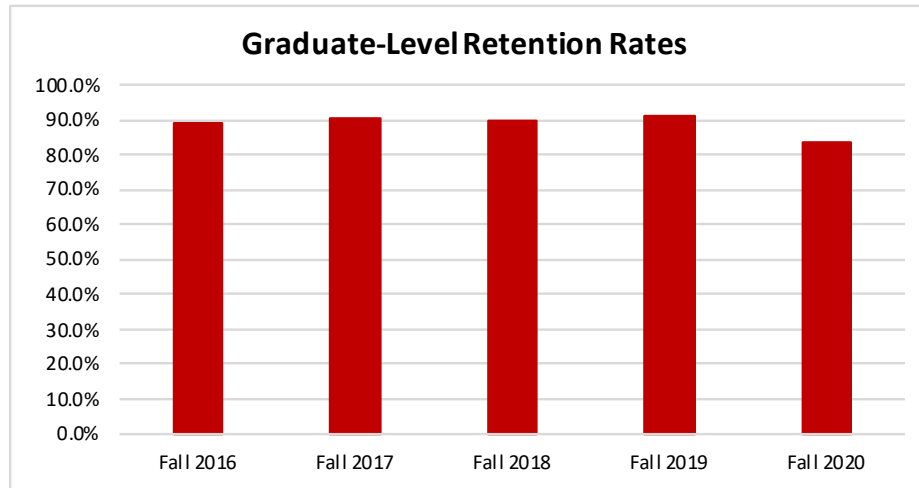

<sup>1</sup> Graduate-level retention rates are calculated for new masters and doctoral students only. Both full-time and part-time students are included. Students are excluded from the cohort if they died or if they graduated in the same plan at the same level (masters/doctoral) before the second fall. Students are counted as retained if they continued in a masters or doctoral plan the second fall.
